
The Bible tells us that Jesus...

WHAT DO CHRISTIANS BELIEVE ABOUT JESUS?

Christians believe that Jesus was human. A real man who was born and lived in Israel over 2,000 years ago. He walked and talked and did everything that every other human has ever done.

They also believe that He was God in human form, sent to earth to save us from our sins.

This is known as INCARNATION.

HOW DO WE KNOW JESUS EXISTED?

There is a tremendous amount of historical evidence that Jesus was a real man who lived in Israel.

TASK: Explain what the Bible tells us about Jesus' life

The second place to look for evidence of Jesus' existence is within contemporary historical accounts.

Within a few decades of His lifetime, Jesus is mentioned by Jewish and Roman historians, as well as by dozens of Christian writings.

WHY DO CHRISTIANS THINK JESUS WAS HUMAN?

Much of what we know about Jesus comes from the first 4 books of the New Testament, i.e. the Gospels.

'THE WORD BECAME A HUMAN BEING AND, FULL OF GRACE AND TRUTH, LIVED AMONG US.' JOHN 1:14

The Bible says that Jesus (The Word) became human and lived on earth.

We're going to spend some time now digging into the Bible to find evidence for Jesus being a human being...

'SHE GAVE BIRTH TO HER FIRST SON,
WRAPPED HIM IN CLOTHS AND LAID HIM IN A
MANGER—THERE WAS NO ROOM FOR THEM
TO STAY IN THE INN.'

LUKE 2:7

AS THEY WERE SAILING, JESUS FELL ASLEEP. SUDDENLY A STRONG WIND BLEW DOWN ON THE LAKE, AND THE BOAT BEGAN TO FILL WITH WATER, SO THAT THEY WERE ALL IN GREAT DANGER. 'LUKE 8:23

'AFTER SPENDING FORTY DAYS AND NIGHTS WITHOUT FOOD, JESUS WAS HUNGRY.'

MATTHEW 4:2

'AN ANGEL FROM HEAVEN APPEARED TO HIM AND STRENGTHENED HIM. IN GREAT ANGUISH HE PRAYED EVEN MORE FERVENTLY; HIS SWEAT WAS LIKE DROPS OF BLOOD FALLING TO THE GROUND.' LUKE 22:43-44

'ONE OF THE SOLDIERS PLUNGED HIS SPEAR INTO JESUS' SIDE, AND AT ONCE BLOOD AND WATER POURED OUT.'

JOHN 19:34

'I HAVE TOLD YOU THIS SO THAT MY JOY MAY BE IN YOU AND THAT YOUR JOY MAY BE COMPLETE.'

JOHN 15:11

'JESUS WAS ANGRY AS HE LOOKED AROUND AT THEM, BUT AT THE SAME TIME HE FELT SORRY FOR THEM, BECAUSE THEY WERE SO STUBBORN AND WRONG...' MARK 3:5

'THEN JESUS WENT WITH HIS DISCIPLES TO A PLACE CALLED GETHSEMANE, AND HE SAID TO THEM, "SIT HERE WHILE I GO OVER THERE AND PRAY." HE TOOK WITH HIM PETER AND THE TWO SONS OF ZEBEDEE. GRIEF AND ANGUISH CAME OVER HIM, AND HE SAID TO THEM, "THE SORROW IN MY HEART IS SO GREAT THAT IT ALMOST CRUSHES ME. STAY HERE AND KEEP WATCH WITH ME.' MATTHEW 26: 36-38

WHY DO CHRISTIANS THINK JESUS WAS GOD?

So, we've found loads of evidence for Jesus being human. But what about the God part?

We're now going to check out the Bible for evidence that He was God. Move along now, there's plenty to see...

An angel (to Mary):

"...THEREFORE THE CHILD TO BE BORN WILL BE CALLED HOLY—THE SON OF GOD." LUKE 1:35

How does this Bible verse show us Jesus was God?

At Jesus' baptism:

THEN A VOICE SAID FROM HEAVEN, "THIS IS MY OWN DEAR SON, WITH WHOM I AM PLEASED." MATTHEW 3:17

Jesus spoke about it:

'AGAIN THE HIGH PRIEST ASKED HIM, 'ARE YOU THE CHRIST, THE SON OF GOD?' AND JESUS SAID, 'I AM, AND YOU WILL SEE THE SON OF MAN SEATED AT THE RIGHT HAND OF THE MIGHTY ONE, AND COMING ON THE CLOUDS OF HEAVEN.' MARK 14:61-62

Jesus performs miracles:

'JESUS TOOK THE BLIND MAN BY THE HAND AND LED HIM OUT OF THE VILLAGE. AFTER SPITTING ON THE MAN'S EYES, JESUS PLACED HIS HANDS ON HIM AND ASKED HIM, "CAN YOU SEE ANYTHING?" THE MAN LOOKED UP AND SAID, "YES, I CAN SEE PEOPLE, BUT THEY LOOK LIKE TREES WALKING AROUND." JESUS AGAIN PLACED HIS HANDS ON THE MAN'S EYES. THIS TIME THE MAN LOOKED INTENTLY, HIS EYESIGHT RETURNED, AND HE SAW EVERYTHING CLEARLY.' MARK 8: 23-25

Jesus rose from the dead:

THE ANGEL SPOKE TO THE WOMEN. "YOU MUST NOT BE AFRAID," HE SAID. "I KNOW YOU ARE LOOKING FOR JESUS, WHO WAS CRUCIFIED. HE IS NOT HERE; HE HAS BEEN RAISED, JUST AS HE SAID. COME HERE AND SEE THE PLACE WHERE HE WAS LYING. GO QUICKLY NOW, AND TELL HIS DISCIPLES, "HE HAS BEEN RAISED FROM DEATH, AND NOW HE IS GOING TO GALILEE AHEAD OF YOU; THERE YOU WILL SEE HIM!" REMEMBER WHAT I HAVE TOLD YOU." MATTHEW 28: 5-7

Others: John the Baptist

'AND I HAVE SEEN AND HAVE BORNE WITNESS THAT THIS IS THE SON OF GOD.' JOHN 1:34

Others: the disciples

AND THOSE IN THE BOAT WORSHIPPED HIM, SAYING, 'TRULY YOU ARE THE SON OF GOD." MATTHEW 14:33

Others: Paul

HE WAS DECLARED TO BE THE SON OF GOD IN POWER, ACCORDING TO THE SPIRIT OF HOLINESS BY HIS RESURRECTION FROM THE DEAD, JESUS CHRIST OUR LORD.' ROMANS 1:4

FULFILMENT OF OLD TESTAMENT PROPHECY

In the Old Testament there are many prophecies. They tell of a man who will come to save the Jewish people. This man was known as the Messiah.

Christians believe Jesus was the Messiah. You can read more about this <u>here.</u>

DEFINITION ALERT: A prophecy is a message from God, sometimes a prediction of something that will happen.

FULFILMENT OF OLD TESTAMENT PROPHECY

The book of Isaiah was written around 700 years before Jesus was born.

It contains many prophecies about the Messiah - how he would be born of a virgin, that he would be rejected by many and would die a horrible death.

One of the most famous sections is Chapter 53 Read it <u>here.</u>

FULFILMENT OF OLD TESTAMENT PROPHECY

The psalms were also written hundreds of years before Jesus was born. Furthermore, Psalm 22 was written hundreds of years before the Romans used crucifixion as a form of execution.

And yet, Psalm 22 reads suspiciously like a description of Jesus' death...

Select and explain 4 ways in which these texts match.

Do you think the prophecies from Isaiah and Psalm 22 provide evidence that Jesus was God? Why/why not? Refer to Isaiah, Psalm 22 and Matthew 27 in your answer.
