WHY DO CHRISTIANS THINK FORGIVENESS IS IMPORTANT?

Christians get their ideas about all kinds of stuff from the Bible. In particular, they love to follow what Jesus taught them. They read what he taught and how he behaved and it shows them how to behave.

To understand why Christians think forgiveness is important we are going to have a closer look at a story Jesus told called the Parable of the Lost Son.
