READ THE PARABLE OF THE SHEEP AND THE GOATS BELOW:

When the Son of Man comes as King... he will divide them into two groups, just as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats. He will put the good people on his right (sheep) and the bad people on his left (goats).

The Sheep:

Then the King will say to the people on his right, 'Come, you that are blessed by my Father!...

I was hungry and you fed me,

thirsty and you gave me a drink;

I was a stranger and you received me in your homes,

naked and you clothed me;

I was sick and you took care of me,

in prison and you visited me...

The Goats:

"Then he will say to those on his left, 'Away from me, you that are under God's curse!...

I was hungry but you would not feed me,

thirsty but you would not give me a drink;

I was a stranger but you would not welcome me in your homes,

naked but you would not clothe me;

I was sick and in prison but you would not take care of me.'...

The King will reply, 'I tell you, whenever you refused to help one of these least important ones, you refused to help me.' These, then, will be sent off to eternal punishment, but the righteous will go to eternal life."
